**EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 2022 - 15**

### **AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE COMPOSITION OF THE MANILA BAY TASK FORCE GROUP (MBTFG)**

**WHEREAS**, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) directs the creation of Manila Bay Task Force Group at the provincial, municipal and city level in conformity with R.A. 9003, otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act 2000. This gives the Local Government with the primary responsibility in carrying out the mandate of implementing Manila Bay Task Force (MBTF) Program within their respective jurisdiction;

**WHEREAS**, DILG issued Memorandum Circular No. 2022-090 dates June 28, 2022, rationalizing the establishment of Manila Bay Task Force (MBTF) in Local Government Units within the Manila Bay Watershed Area;

**WHEREAS**, Section 4 of the DILG issued Memorandum Circular No. 2022-090, Composition of the Vice-Chairperson and member requires Head of Budget Office, Head of Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office and Head of Agriculture. Hence, composition of the Manila Bay Task Force Group (MBTFG) needs to be reconstituted pursuant to the Policy Guidelines set forth in the same DILG Memorandum Circular.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, VERGEL C. MENESES**, Municipal Mayor of Bulakan, Bulacan, by virtue of the power vested upon me by the law as the Chief, do hereby order:

**SECTION 1. Short Title.** – This Executive Order shall also be known as “Reorganizing the Composition of The Manila Bay Task Force Group (MBTFG)”.

**SECTION 2. Composition.** – The Manila Bay Task Force Group (MBTFG) shall be be composed of the following:

The Vice Chair-persons shall be designated as the Action Plan Man who shall be responsible for providing technical support and training and other assistance as may be required from time to time.

### **SECTION 3. Function:**

- 3.1. Develop Manila Bay Task Force Plan that shall endure the long-term management of solid waste and strategize to extinguish the solid waste disposal on the nearby waterways and bodies of water connected to the Manila Bay;

- 3.2. Collaborate and cooperate with the Barangay Officials on taking measures regarding the preservation of all tributary leading to Manila Bay. The MBTFG will consistently monitor the situation in the Barangay;
- 3.3. Adopt measures to promote and ensure the viability and effectiveness of the Manila Bay Task Force program in its component barangay;
- 3.4. Continuous monitoring of the implementation of Manila Bay Task Force program with the cooperation of Barangay Officers;
- 3.5. Convene regular meeting for the purpose of planning and coordinating the implementation of Manila Bay Task Force functions;
- 3.6. Develop specific mechanics and guidelines for the proper disposal of solid waste and advise to relocate the informal settler if any, the manila task force should effectively explain to the component barangays its responsibility in preserving the environment;
- 3.7. Conduct inspection on household, establishment, factory, restaurant, leisure park, hotel of their septage disposal;
- 3.8. Enforce sanctions to the violator/s and offender/s rightfully to the impact of their doings against the preservation of Manila Bay; and
- 3.9. Provide incentive to any individual or group who will pass the criteria set by the board.

**SECTION 4. Meetings.** – MBTFG shall meet at least once every quarters or as often as necessary.

**SECTION 5. Duration.** - This policy should take effect immediately, and shall remain effective until further orders from this office.

**SECTION 6. Repealing Clause.** – All executive orders, issuances, rules and regulations or part thereof which are found, to be inconsistent, in conflict, or contrary to the provisions set by this orders are hereby repealed, amended and modified accordingly.

**SECTION 7. Effectivity.** This Executive Order shall take effect after signing and shall remain in effect until revoked.
